Chapter 01:The Virtue and Encouragement of Marriage

#Hadith 01:

الإمام الرضا (عليه السلام): لو لم تكن في المناكحة والمصاهرة آية محكمة ولا سنة متبعة، لكان فيما جعل الله فيها من بر القريب وتألف البعيد، ما رغب فيه العاقل اللبيب وسارع إليه الموفق المصيب

Imam Al-Ridha (peace be upon him) said: "If there were no definitive verse in the Qur'an or established tradition regarding marriage and kinship, the good that Allah has placed in it, such as fostering ties with relatives and uniting with strangers, would be enough to inspire the wise and encourage the successful to seek it."

The Prophet (peace be upon him and his family) said:

"No structure has been built in Islam more beloved to Allah, the Almighty and Glorious, and more honored than marriage."²

#Hadith 03:

The Prophet (peace be upon him and his family) said:

"Marry and increase in number, for I will take pride in your multitude before the nations on the Day of Judgment — even with the miscarried fetus."³

A man came to Abu 'Abdillah (peace be upon him) and said to him: "Do you have a wife?" He replied: "No." My father (i.e., Imam Ja'far al-Sadiq) then said: "I would not like to have the entire world and all that is in it if I were to spend a single night without a wife." Then he said: "Two units of prayer performed by a married man are better than a night spent in worship and a day spent fasting by a single man." Then my father gave the man seven dinars and said to him: "Get married with this." Then my father said: "The Messenger of Allah (peace and blessings be upon him and his family) said: Take spouses, for it is more likely to increase your sustenance."

Imam Jafar(peace be upon him) said: "A young man from the Ansar came to the Messenger of Allah (peace be upon him and his family) and complained of need (poverty). The Prophet said to him: "Get married." The young man replied, "I am too shy to return to the Prophet." Then a man from the Ansar said, "I have a beautiful daughter; marry her to him." So Allah expanded his provision. The young man went back to the Prophet and informed him, whereupon the Prophet (peace be upon him and his family) said: "O young people, marriage is prescribed for you."

Chapter 04: Whoever strives in facilitating marriage...

#Hadith 01:

قال أمير المؤمنين (عليه السلام): أفضل الشفاعات أن تشفع بين اثنين في نكاح حتى يجمع الله بينهما.

Ameerul Momineen(peace be upon him) said: "The best intercession is to intercede between two people for marriage until Allah unites them.."¹⁶

عن أبي عبد الله (عليه السلام) قال: من زوج أعزبا كان ممن ينظر الله عز وجل إليه يوم القيامة.

Imam Jafar(peace be upon him) said: "Whoever marries off a single person will be among those whom Allah, the Mighty and Majestic, will look upon with favor on the Day of Resurrection."¹⁷

عن النبي (صلى الله عليه وآله) - في حديث - قال: ومن عمل في تزويج بين مؤمنين حتى يجمع بينهما زوجه الله عز وجل ألف امرأة من الحور العين، كل امرأة في قصر من در وياقوت، وكان له بكل خطوة خطاها أو بكل كلمة تكلم بها في ذلك عمل سنة قيام ليلها وصيام نهارها، ومن عمل في فرقة بين امرأة وزوجها كان عليه غضب الله ولعنته في الدنيا والآخرة، وكان حقا على الله أن يرضخه بألف صخرة. من نار، ومن مشى في فساد ما بينهما ولم يفرق كان في سخط الله عز وجل ولعنته في الدنيا والآخرة، وحرم (الله عليه) (2) النظر إلى وجهه.

The Prophet (peace be upon him and his family) said in a narration:

"Whoever works to marry two believers so that Allah unites them in marriage, Allah Almighty will grant him a thousand women from the Houris, each woman in a palace made of pearls and rubies. For every step he takes or every word he speaks in that matter, it will be recorded as the reward of a year of night prayers and day fasting.

But whoever causes separation between a woman and her husband, Allah's wrath and curse will be upon him in this world and the Hereafter, and it will be incumbent upon Allah to crush him with a thousand fiery stones.

And whoever walks in causing corruption between them without separating them will be under the anger and curse of Allah in this world and the Hereafter, and Allah will forbid him from looking at His Face."¹⁸

Chapter 05: A Woman's Criteria for choosing a Spouse

Following are the ahadees on recommendation for a woman and her family to choose a husband whose character, religion, and trustworthiness please them, who is chaste and wealthy, and that it is not permissible to reject him if he proposes.

#Hadith 01:

كتب علي بن أسباط إلى أبي جعفر عليه السلام في أمر بناته وأنه لا يجد أحدا مثله، فكتب إليه أبو جعفر عليه السلام: فهمت ما ذكرت من أمر بناتك وأنك لا تجد أحدا مثلك، فلا تنظر في ذلك رحمك الله، فإن رسول الله صلى الله عليه وآله قال: إذا جاءكم من ترضون خلقه ودينه فزوجوه إلا تفعلوه تكن فتنة في الأرض وفساد كبير. ورواه الشيخ بإسناده عن علي بن الحسن بن فضال، عن علي بن مهزيار قال: قرأت كتاب أبي جعفر عليه السلام إلى ابن شيبة وذكر مثله. ورواه ابن طاوس في كتاب (الاستخارات) نقلا من كتاب الرسائل لمحمد بن يعقوب الكليني في رسائل الأئمة عليهم السلام فيما يختص بالجواد عليه السلام من رسالة له عليه السلام إلى على بن أسباط وذكر مثله.

Ali ibn Asbat wrote to Imam Baqir(peace be upon him) regarding his daughters and mentioned that he could not find anyone like himself (as a suitable match for them). Imam Baqir(peace be upon him) wrote back to him:

"I understood what you mentioned regarding your daughters and that you do not find anyone like yourself. Do not concern yourself with that, may Allah have mercy on you. For the Messenger of Allah (peace be upon him and his family) said: 'If someone whose character and religion you are pleased with comes to you (seeking marriage), then marry him (to your daughters). If you do not do so, there will be tribulation on the earth and widespread corruption."

عن إبراهيم بن محمد الهمداني قال: كتبت إلى أبي جعفر عليه السلام في التزويج، فأتاني كتابه بخطه قال رسول الله صلى الله عليه وآله: إذا جاءكم من ترضون خلقه ودينه فزوجوه إلا تفعلوه تكن فتنة في الأرض وفساد كبير

From Ibrahim ibn Muhammad al-Hamadani:

He said, "I wrote to Imam Baqir(peace be upon him) regarding marriage, and a letter came to me in his handwriting in which he wrote:

The Messenger of Allah (peace be upon him and his family) said:

'If someone whose character and religion you are pleased with comes to you (seeking marriage), then marry him. If you do not do so, there will be tribulation on the earth and great corruption."²⁰

Imam Jafar(peace be upon him), he said:

Imam Ali(as) asked, "O Messenger of Allah, what if he is worldly in his lineage?"

He replied,

"If someone whose character and religion you are pleased with comes to you,

then marry him. If you do not do so, there will be tribulation on the earth and great corruption."²²

#Hadith 05:

قال أبو عبد الله عليه السلام: الكفؤ أن يكون عفيفا وعنده يسار.

Imam Jafar(peace be upon him) said:

"The suitable match (kaf') is one who is chaste and has financial means."23

Chapter 05: A Man's Criteria for choosing a Spouse

#Hadith 01:

عن أبي عبد الله عليه السلام قال: إذا تزوج الرجل المرأة لجمالها أو لمالها وكل إلى ذلك، وإذا تزوجها لدينها رزقه الله المال والجمال.

Imam Jafar(peace be upon him) said:

"If a man marries a woman for her beauty or her wealth, he will be left to that (alone). But if he marries her for her religion, Allah will grant him both wealth and beauty."²⁴

#Hadith 02:

قال أبو جعفر عليه السلام: أتي رجل النبي صلى الله عليه وآله يستأمره في النكاح، فقال رسول الله صلى الله عليه وآله: انكح وعليك بذات الدين تربت يداك.

Imam Baqir(peace be upon him) said:

A man came to the Prophet (peace be upon him and his family) seeking his advice about marriage. The Messenger of Allah (peace be upon him and his

family) said:

"Marry, and choose the one who is religious — may your hands be covered in dust!"

("May your hands be covered in dust" is an Arabic expression implying urgency or encouragement, not a literal curse.)²⁵

#Hadith 03:

قال رسول الله صلى الله عليه وآله: من تزوج امرأة لا يتزوجها إلا لجمالها لم ير فيها ما يحب، ومن تزوجها لمالها لا يتزوجها إلا له وكله الله إليه فعليكم بذات الدين.

The Messenger of Allah (peace be upon him and his family) said:

"Whoever marries a woman solely for her beauty will not find in her what he loves, and whoever marries her for her wealth will marry her for it alone, and Allah will entrust her to him. So, choose the one who is religious."²⁶

#Hadith 04:

أن النبي صلى الله عليه وآله قال: من تزوج امرأة لمالها وكله الله إليه، ومن تزوجها لجمالها رأى فيها ما يكره، ومن تزوجها لدينها جمع الله له ذلك.

The Messenger of Allah (peace be upon him and his family) said:

"Whoever marries a woman for her wealth, Allah will entrust her to him; whoever marries her for her beauty will find in her what he dislikes; and whoever marries her for her religion, Allah will unite for him all of that."²⁷

Chapter 05: It is permissible for a man to look at the face, hands, hair, and beauty of a woman he wants to marry

#Hadith 01:

عن أبي عبد الله عليه السلام قال: لا بأس بأن ينظر إلى وجهها ومعاصمها إذا أراد أن يتزوجها..

The Jafar (peace be upon him and his family) said:

"It is permissible to look at her face and wrists if he intends to marry her."28

#Hadith 02:

قلت لأبي عبد الله عليه السلام: الرجل يريد أن يتزوج المرأة يتأملها وينظر إلى خلفها وإلى وجهها؟ قال: نعم لا بأس أن ينظر الرجل إلى المرأة إذا أراد أن يتزوجها ينظر إلى خلفها وإلى وجهها..

Al-Hasan bin Al-Sarry said to Abu Abdullah (peace be upon him):

A man wants to marry a woman — can he look at her and observe her back and her face?He (peace be upon him) said:

Yes, there is no problem if a man looks at a woman when he wants to marry her; he may look at her back and her face.²⁹
